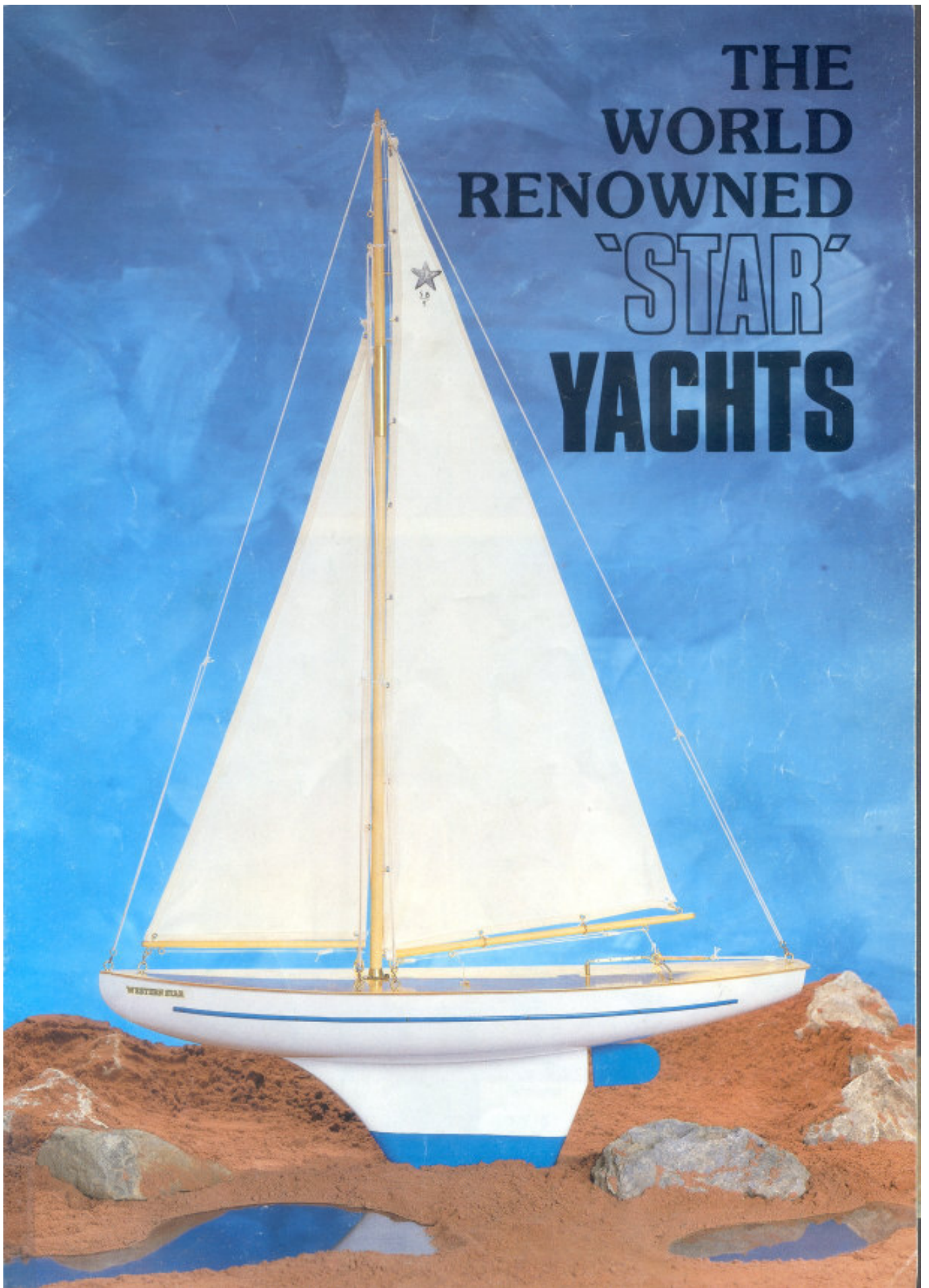

The founder of "Star Productions", Franz Marie Denye, was a partner in a centuries old Belgian family ship-building firm. When Germany invaded Belgium in World War I he put his family and possessions into a newly launched fishing trawler and sailed to England — he chose Merseyside as a likely area to seek his fortune. After five years in the shipyards of Birkenhead he founded the "Star Yacht Works" where he laid the foundations of the present "Star Productions". Now, over 60 years later, the word "Star" is synonymous the world over with model, wooden-hulled sailing yachts. Today, the third generation partners, P. J. and F. J. Denye, confidently look forward to carrying on the tradition of reliability and quality established over the years.

"STAR" DUTCH FISHING BARGES (Illustrated below)

Toy models of the genuine Dutch fishing vessels. These craft are flat-bottomed and finished in a brilliant yellow, being lined and holed in red or blue. The sails are of white cotton, hemmed and cross stitched in red which, together with the waxed spars, makes a really colourful display. Ideal for the bath, nursery, garden pool or shallow lake at the seaside.

SY/00 (Illustrated above)

This is a miniature version of its larger brothers, the "Popular Series". Although fitted with a correctly weighted keel, it is not intended for sailing in competition with the larger models and is more suited to the bath or nursery pool. Enamelled in red or blue with white lined hull, it will give endless pleasure to the "toddler".

SY/0, SY/1, SY/2 and SY/3

These are the "junior" models of the most popular and widely known series of Toy Sailing Yachts in the British Isles. The three smallest sizes are finished in assorted colours with white lined deck and hull, polished birch spars and white cotton sails. The rigging is hinged to the deck and all metal fittings are nickel-plated and electro-brassed. The SY/3 is enamelled in assorted sea blue and canary yellow, with red keel and deep matching border line. All spars, with the addition of a bowsprit, are waxed for long life.

SY/4 and SY/5

These are the "middle generation" of the "Star" Popular Series. Both models benefit from the addition of a jib-sail for improved performance. The SY/5 has an adjustable gaff and solid brass sheet-horse, together with a more elaborate keel, as illustrated.

COLOUR DETAILS

SY/4 Assorted colours consisting of brilliant orange, sea blue and canary yellow, with blue keel and deep border line.

SY/5 White hull with contrasting keel and border line in green, together with lined and varnished deck. Bow name transfer "Northern Star".

MK/1 and MK/2

De-luxe hollow versions of the Popular Series, designed to outsail, size for size, their solid-hulled counterparts. Fitted with marine plywood decks, lined and varnished in Polyurethane Lacquer. Hulls and keels finished in brilliant white enamel, tastefully lined in assorted colours. Semi-fixed rudders are fitted to give additional control. Bow name transfers are "Endeavour I" and "Endeavour II".

SY/6 and SY/7

The "senior" models of the Popular Series, these boats represent the ultimate in solid-hulled sailing yachts. The HAND-CARVED hull, together with heavy metal keel, gives sailing qualities surprising for their size. As with the SY/5, gaffs are fitted to facilitate erection and collapsing of the large rigging and to reduce overall packed size.

COLOUR DETAILS

SY/6 21" (530 mm Hull). Brilliant white hull, rich blue keel and border line — lined and varnished deck. White sails with brass eyelets and waxed spars. Bow name transfer "Southern Star".

SY/7 24" (610 mm Hull). As above but with red keel and deep red border line. Bow name transfer "Ocean Star".

The yachts illustrated above probably represent the two finest ranges of racing models available today. The construction is entirely by hand, carried out by craftsmen of long experience. All metal fittings are of solid brass, the sails are of finest quality waxed cambric, taped for reinforcement, whilst for the hulls and keels only selected seasoned timber is used.

The BR range is golden varnished to reveal the natural grain of the timber and is enamelled in various colours above the water line, the leaded portion of the keel being painted to match, as illustrated above. The two larger sizes are equipped with deck fittings which allow the sails to be easily detached.

The SB yachts are superior editions of the BR models, being fitted with the exclusive "Star" Automatic Steering Gear. All suits of sails are easily removed. The mast of the SB/5 comes in two sections, being connected by means of a brass tube. The hull is enamelled in white with the buffer-strip, leaded keel and rudder picked out in blue. The deck, which is lined to represent planking, is lacquered in marine yacht varnish.
